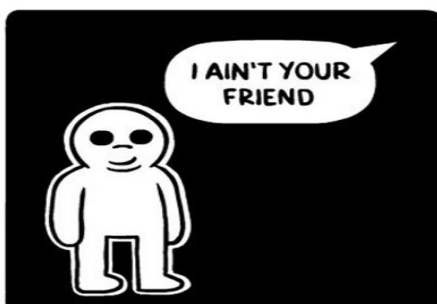
What's New - Annie Woods

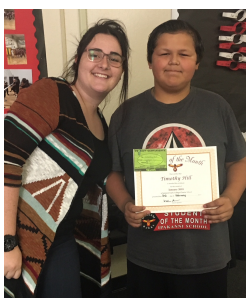


School News - Annie Woods (5th Grade)

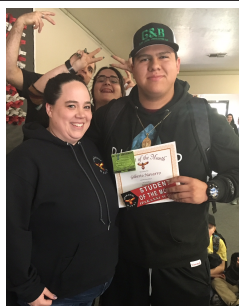

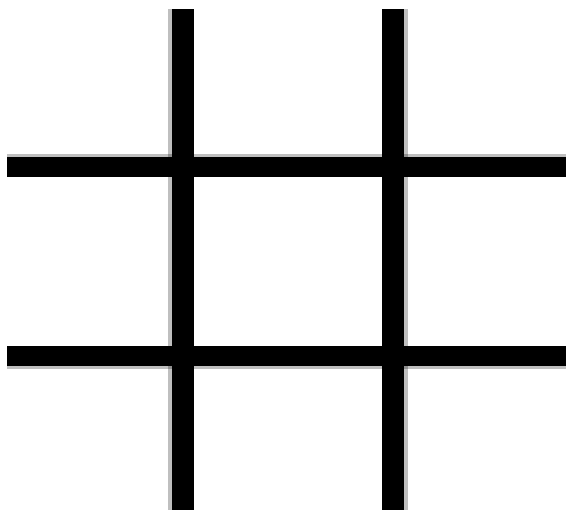
